

Privacy Policy

Tauranga Blue Rovers Football Club

The principles of the Privacy Act 1993 will be reflected in the activities of the Tauranga Blue Rovers Football Club ("TBR", "Club").

- Personal information collected by the Club will be for a necessary and lawful purpose connected with the
 activities of the Club. This includes but is not limited to passing the information onto the Waibop Football and
 New Zealand Football.
- Personal information will be collected only with the knowledge and informed consent of the person concerned.
- TBR will not disclose personal information to anyone other than the person concerned unless; disclosure is for the purpose the information was obtained, the source of the information is publicly available, disclosure is authorised by the person concerned, disclosure is necessary to prevent or lessen serious threat to public health or individuals' life or health, disclosure is requested by the police.
- Bulk email communication will be sent using the blind carbon copy ("bcc") function.
- Personal information will be stored to meet the requirements of the Privacy Act 1993.
- TBR's designated Privacy Officer is the Secretary of the Club.
- The club may use photographs of members taken in public places during games, trainings and other club programmes for promotional purposes. Member's full names will not be attached to photographs unless permission has been sought from the member and/or their parent/guardian if under 20. Photos used for promotional purposes will be removed if requested by a member or their parent/guardian.
